

Master of Education (MEd) 교육학석사과정

● Introduction (English Program)

The Master of Education (MEd) is a two-year program for current and future teachers and administrators who desire Christian integration in their vocation. It is mainly designed to produce Christian teachers and administrators capable of educating their students in primary and secondary schools from a biblical worldview. The program's emphasis lies on developing students' Christian worldview as well as their educational and administrative knowledge and skills through a variety of biblically integrated courses and practices. The program has two tracks: 1) Teacher Track and 2) Administrator Track. Teacher Track students can earn a professional teacher certificate from the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI). By taking additional courses, Administrator Track students can earn the ACSI principal certificate in addition to the teacher certificate.

Administrator Track: Total 45 credits

For graduation, total 36 credits for Teacher track (min. 26 educational studies credits + 9 biblical studies credits) and 45 credits for Administrator track are required.

For ACSI Teacher Certificate, 36 credits (Teacher Track requirement) plus PFE I & II are required. For ACSI Principal Certificate, 45 credits (Administrator Track requirement) plus PFE I & II are required.

* These courses are offered biennially.

** This course can be replaced upon evaluation of a sample paper (APA format, 5-6 pages, double space, Times New Roman, 12 points) and an editing test.

*** Students must fulfill the field education (FE) requirement in a local church or a Christian organization while they are enrolled at TTGU. To receive a P (pass) grade, the student should i) register for Field Education I-II and ii) submit the Field Education report to the Pro-gram Director signed by the field supervisor by the 15th week of the semester.

► **<MEd: Track A> Teacher Track**

The Teacher Track is for MEd students who want to teach in a Christian school and/or pursue the ACSI (Association of Christian Schools International) Professional Teacher Certificate. Upon completion of the program, students in this track will be eligible for the teacher certificate.

► <MEd: Track B> Administrator Track

The Administrator Track is for MEd students who want to serve a Christian school as an administrative leader or a principal and/or who want to earn the ACSI Professional Principal Certificate. Upon completion of the program, any student in this track will be eligible for both the teacher and principal certificates with some additional coursework.

* Administrator Track students may be required to pay an extra 1 credit fee for three semesters. Up to 2 additional credits over the load (11 credits) are allowed for an extra fee.
