

# Master of Theological Studies (MTS)

## ● Introduction (English Program)

The Master of Theological Studies (MTS) is a two-year degree focused on general theological studies. This program aims to provide enriching theological training for professionals and leaders across various fields. The curriculum covers a wide range of theological and foundational disciplines, along with practical and applied subjects. Students have the flexibility to select elective courses and design their own concentration areas (biblical/theological studies, missions, practical theology, Christian counseling, Christian education, etc.) according to their educational interests and career objectives.
