# ► E MEd - Track A. Teacher Track

Teacher Track is for any MEd students who want to serve a Christian school as a teacher and/or who is pursuing to receive the ACSI (Association of Christian Schools International) Professional Teacher Certificate. On completion of the program, students in this track will be eligible for the teacher certificate without extra course-taking other than the program requirements.

# ► E MEd - Track B. Administrator Track

Administrator Track is for any MEd students who want to serve a Christian school as an administrative leader or a principal and/or who is pursuing to receive the ACSI Professional Principal Certificate. On completion of the program, any student in this track will be eligible for both the teacher and principal certificate with some extra course-taking.

\* Administrator Track students might have to pay extra 1 credit fee for three semesters. Up to 2 additional credits over the load (11 credits) are allowed to be taken with extra fee.
